



Physicians Immediate Care requires employees to follow our dress code and wear the following uniforms:

Providers:

- Are required to wear a lab coat if you are in scrubs.

Clinic Staff:

- Are required to wear PIC-issued scrubs.
- PCT and RT's need their own stethoscope as well as a watch with a second hand

Physical Therapists:

- Are required to wear PIC-issued polo shirts with casual pants, no jeans.

Clinic Support Staff:

- Are required to wear business casual.

All Staff:

- Undershirts may be worn in grey, white, black & red
- No Jackets or overcoats permitted, unless embroidered with the PIC logo
- Nametags must be visible
- Tattoos should be covered
- Piercings removed for safety.
- Closed toed, slip resistant shoes for safety
- No scented lotions, perfume, or cologne

Failure to Comply

Interpretation of the dress code is at the discretion of management, and any employee reporting to work wearing apparel outside of the dress code or not having a neat and clean appearance will be asked to leave and return properly attired. Any time spent away from work because of being asked to leave will not be compensated. Violation of the personal appearance and dress code may result in disciplinary action.
